## 5 – 11 FEBRUARY 2023

The competitions are organised according to the official rules of the EFNS.

### Categories

The categories are divided according to sex and age groups.

### Who can participate at EFNS?

As the name of EFNS implies: EFNS is a biathlon competition for European foresters. However, not only foresters are allowed to participate! The following people can participate in the races:

- people who work in forestry companies/wood processing industry;
- retired former workers of forestry/wood processing companies;
- pupils and students from the forestry/ecology sector;
- forest owners;
- foresters;
- people who have completed studies or education in the forestry/ecology sector;
- loggers;
- family members of all these groups.

We also warmly welcome all people who work in the wood processing industry, especially:

- people who work in sawmills;
- carpenters;
- people who work in the production of wood pellets;
- people who work in the wood industry.

Also, keep in mind that you are allowed to participate only if you have permanent residence in a European country.

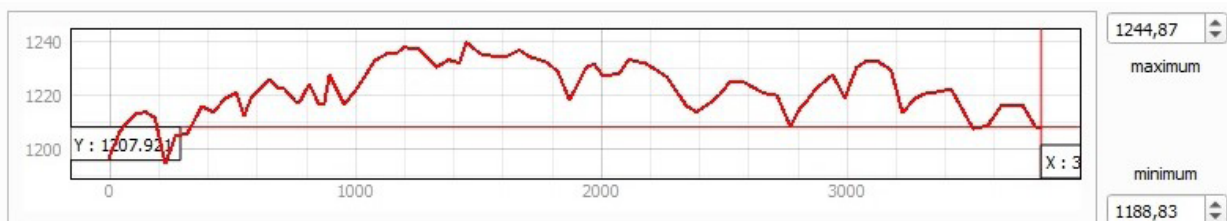

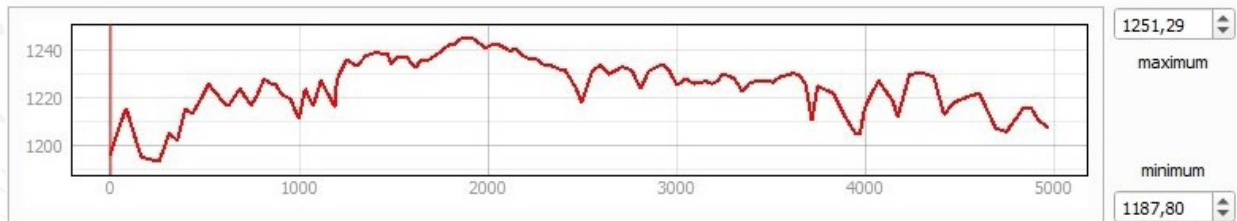
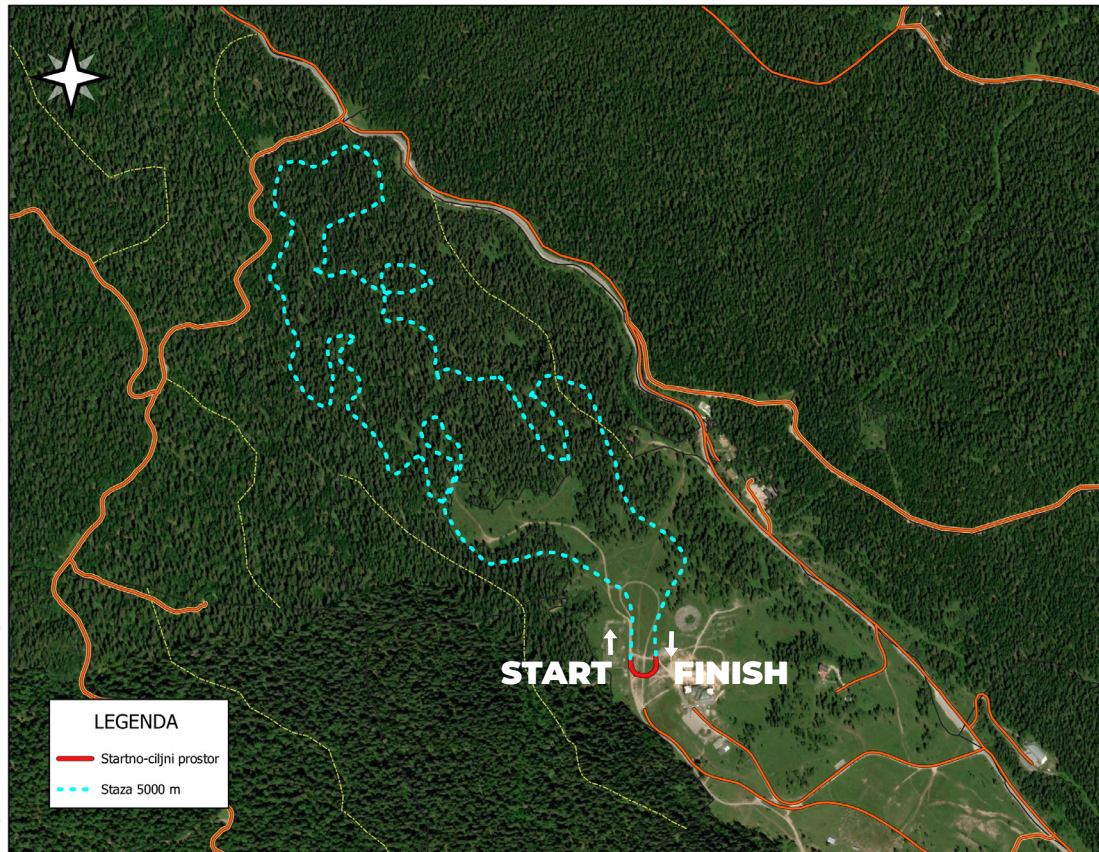

## Shooting

5 shots, 50 meters, standing position. For each round out of the target area a penalty circle of 150 meters must be run. For safety reasons, the rifle must rest on the post when firing.

## Shooting training

The official training is on Tuesday with 10 test shots. Accreditation for shooting training is mandatory.

## Time penalties

Each missed shot, or each missed penalty circle results in a time penalty of 2 (two) minutes.

## Disqualification

The following will be disqualified: those who run free technique in a classic competition, those who violate safety rules on the shooting range, those who start without a transponder.

Any lost or unreturned transponder will be invoiced with an additional 90 euros.

## Safety first

Each participant is responsible for his own shot. The weapon is given to the participant only when he is stable and safe. Rifles for left-handers are on the shooting lines no. 1 and no. 2.

## Evaluation - Awards

If at least 3 participants are not registered for one competition, it will not be evaluated and the participants will be assigned to the next stronger category. The first three in each category receive a certificate and a medal. Material prizes and diplomas are provided for places from 4 to 6. In the relay the first three in each category are awarded.

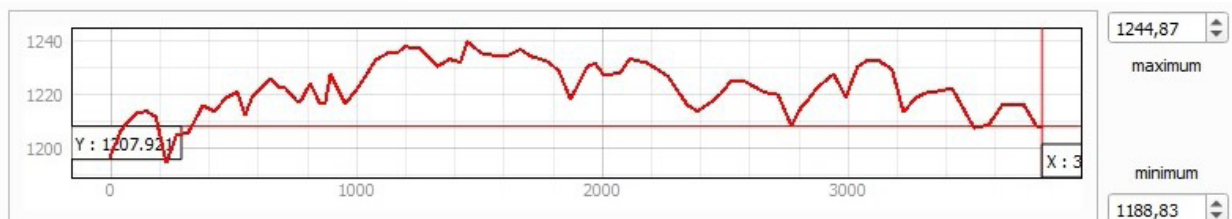

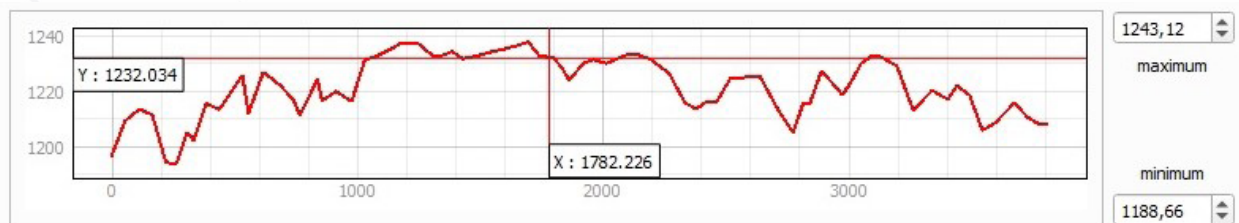
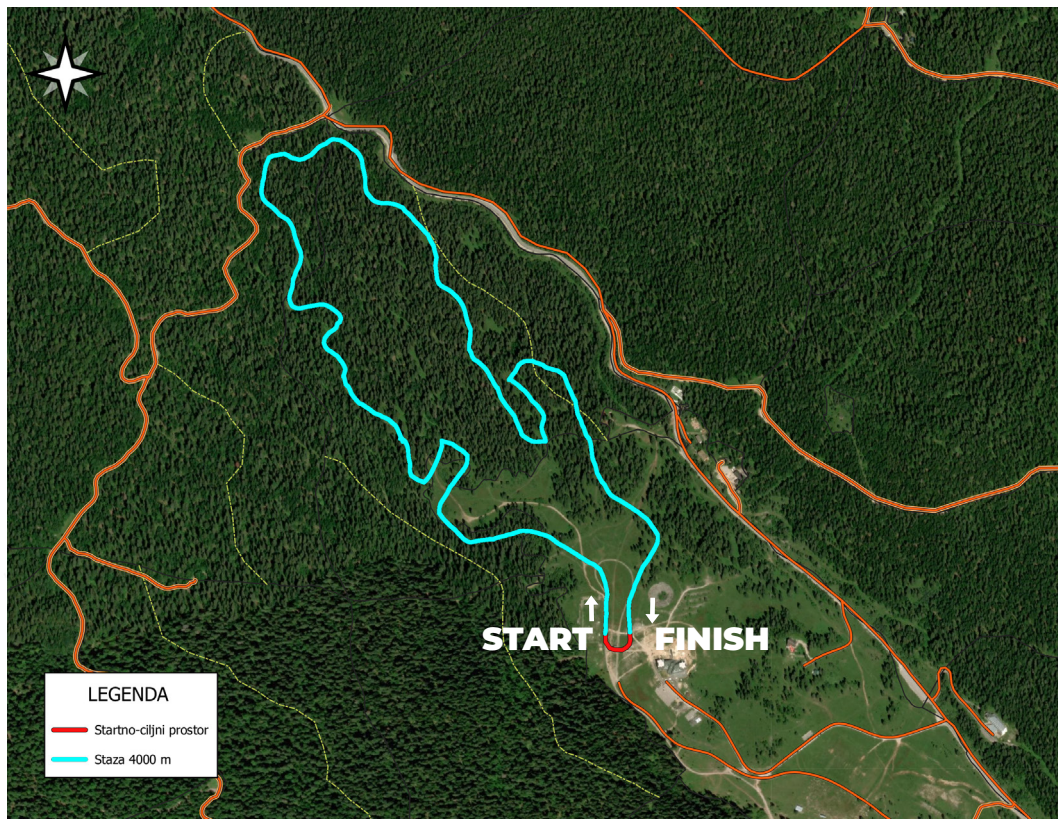

During the entire week, there will be a shuttle service between Hotel Hills and the Biathlon Center Igman - Veliko Polje, departing according to the schedule. The schedule will be published online, sent to the team leaders by email, posted on the windshield of the buses, and included in the start packs.

### Transportation

Transportation is provided as part of the start package on the route Hotel - Biathlon Arena - Hotel.

Transportation on the route from Sarajevo Bus Station to Hotel Hills and Hotel Hollywood is possible by city public transportation or taxi.

Due to the reconstruction of the city's public transportation infrastructure, we recommend using a taxi service that costs around 15 € for city routes.

In his/her own interest, the participant holds a certificate of real insurance against damage and accident and is the owner of a real health certificate and insurance that proves the physical ability to participate in competitions. Regardless of this obligation to provide evidence, the participant releases IC EFNS and the Local Organizing Committee from any kind of responsibility for the damage caused to persons, material or material loss to third parties by the participant, including incurred legal costs for the defense of third party claims. ## HOW TO GET TO SARAJEVO

### By airplane

Sarajevo International Airport is located only 12 kilometers from the center of Sarajevo. It serves as a connection with many European cities and with the rest of the world through major international air hubs, such as Istanbul, Vienna, Berlin, Munich, Zurich and others. The airports in Tuzla and Mostar, both about two hours drive from Sarajevo, operate flights of low-cost airlines.

### By car

Bosnia and Herzegovina is in the process of developing a highway system to make travel more efficient, but it would be good to drive carefully on regional roads. Speed limits are set at: 50-60 km/h within city limits, 80 km/h on open roads and 120 km/h on highways. Tolls for passenger vehicles can be paid in cash (BAM or EUR) or by credit card.

The A1 highway (also connected to the E661 and E73 routes) is a highway in Bosnia and Herzegovina that is part of Corridor 5c and, together with two Croatian highways (A10 and A5) and the Hungarian M6, provides a connection from Budapest to Ploče, a seaport on the Adriatic Sea. The fastest way to Sarajevo from the direction of Zagreb is Gradiška-Doboj-Sarajevo, and from the direction of Osijek it is Brod-Doboj-Sarajevo or Šamac-Doboj-Sarajevo or Orašje-Doboj-Sarajevo.

### By train

Traveling by train in Bosnia and Herzegovina is not sufficiently modernized or popular, but it is a convenient and safe way to travel, especially for low-budget travelers. Sarajevo is directly connected to the capital of Croatia, Zagreb, and from there to the rest of Europe.

### By bus

Sarajevo is connected to many European cities by direct bus lines. The bus company Centrotrans Euro-lines ([www.centrotrans.com](http://www.centrotrans.com)) connects Sarajevo with Austria, Belgium, Montenegro, Denmark, France, the Netherlands, Croatia, Germany, Slovenia and Serbia. Other companies, such as Biss Tours ([www.bisstours.ba](http://www.bisstours.ba)) and Globtour ([www.globtour.com](http://www.globtour.com)), also offer direct bus lines from many European cities to Sarajevo.

In case of an insufficient number of registered people, no refund will be possible, but the participants will be able to choose another excursion with the possibility of additional payment or choose one of the cheaper excursions without refund.

Drinks during excursions are paid in cash.

### Note:

Payments in Bosnia and Herzegovina are made exclusively in Bosnia and Herzegovina convertible marks – KM (BAM), and you can withdraw money at ATMs or change it at exchange offices, which are found in many places in Sarajevo or in hotels.

Please note that it is not possible to pay with debit/credit cards in all places, so we draw your attention to always have money with you in the Bosnian currency – KM.
